1- Magnify My Name

Psalms 34:3 "Glorify the Lord with me. Let us exalt His name together"

John 5:23 "That all may honor the Son just like they honor the Father"

Deuteronomy 13:4 "It is the Lord your God you must follow and Him you must revere"

Psalms 8:1 "Lord, our Lord how majestic is your name in all the earth. You have set your glory in the heavens."

2 Samuel 22:47 "The Lord Lives! Praise be to my rock. Exalted be my God, the rock, my savior. Therefore I will praise you Lord, among the nations; I'll sing the praises of your name."

2- Crown Me Lord of All

4- Listen to Me.

Luke 6:46 "why do you call me Lord, Lord and do not do what I say?"

Malachi 2:22 "If you don't listen and if you do not resolve to honor my name, says the Lord Almighty, "I'll send a curse on you. And I will curse your blessings"

5- Be My Witness

Colossians 1:28 "He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ"
